DIRECTOR'S LETTER

It occurred to me recently that we are halfway through our season of Owning Our Own Story. Until now, I hadn't fully considered where the world might be by the time we arrived at *Seussical*, or how deeply this particular story would resonate with the moment we are living in. These are times that ask us to pay attention and choose how we show up.

Most of the young people in this cast were in first or second grade the last time we produced a full mainstage youth production. That means many of them were between the ages of five and nine during the height of the pandemic - just beginning their journeys into school, where children learn how to take up space, build relationships, and find their voices among their peers. Instead, many spent formative years behind screens, separated from one another, unable to fully read faces or practice the everyday human connections that shape confidence and belonging. For many of these young people, the work of learning how to take up space and claim their voice is still ongoing, which makes *Seussical* feel less like a children's story and more like a necessary act of practice.

And that is where *Seussical* meets us. Not as a nostalgic children's tale, but as a story about listening, believing, and standing up for voices that are often overlooked. This story asks us, young and old alike, to slow down, to listen more closely, and to consider what it means to truly see one another.

How does someone learn to own their own story, or find the courage to do so, when they are constantly being told they don't belong, or that their voice doesn't matter? How does someone so young make an impact in a world that can feel overwhelming? What can they do?

I don't pretend to have all the answers. But I do know this: as adults, it is our responsibility to give them space, to model empathy, curiosity, and courage. To live by Horton's truth: "A person's a person, no matter how small."

And "small" can mean so many things.

No matter what you look like.

No matter who you love.

No matter where you come from.

The list goes on.

I am deeply honored to direct the first youth production back on our stage, and I cannot imagine a more appropriate show. *Seussical* asks us to pay attention to what's happening around us, to how our actions affect others, and to how we show up when someone needs us to speak up.

It asks us to care. Because if we don't care, who will? And how do things get better?

I know these are bigger questions than one might expect when attending a youth production inspired by the words of Dr. Seuss. But as many of us know, his work is filled with hidden lessons, often meant as much for adults as for children.

Perhaps it's time that we sit with those lessons again.




